Thank you for considering volunteering your time and talents to help the homeless animals of Rock County! Volunteers provide our homeless animals with care and compassion and also aid our shelter in so many ways. We look forward to working with you to find a volunteer role that makes full use of your skills, interests, and compassion while contributing to the well-being of the shelter and those we serve.

Most volunteer positions will require a minimum commitment of four hours a month. Please consider whether or not you are able to honor this commitment before turning in the application. All children volunteering with their parent(s) must be under constant parental supervision. For everyone's safety, children are never to be alone with the animals.

To apply:

1. Please review and consider the different volunteer opportunities that are available.
2. Complete a volunteer application, and mail, fax, or drop it off at RCHS.
3. We'll then compare your application with our anticipated volunteer needs for the next six months and contact you to discuss the volunteer position(s) which best match your interest and current shelter needs.

We strive to respond to your application within two weeks. We appreciate your patience! At that time our Volunteer Supervisor will be able to answer your questions and discuss the details of our volunteer positions. Once we've found a volunteer role that is right for you, you'll be invited to attend a volunteer orientation.

At an orientation, you will be taken on a tour of the shelter to get an insider's look into the many efforts that go into animal care at RCHS. You'll also learn more about our programs and policies so you can determine if RCHS is the place for you and start your volunteer work equipped with the information you need to successfully contribute to our mission.

You will then meet with the Volunteer Supervisor, a designated staff member, or seasoned volunteer who will train you in your new role and finalize your volunteer schedule. Our application and training process generally takes one to two months. After these steps are completed, you're ready to volunteer! Thank you!

Volunteer Positions

We know you want to give your time doing something that is rewarding and meaningful while contributing to the care of homeless animals. There are a number of ways to get involved that require different time commitments, schedules, and focus. We look forward to working with you to find the volunteer position that's just right for you!

Animal Care & Comfort:

Animal Transport

Transport animals safely between RCHS and veterinary clinics or rescue organizations. This position is essential in helping RCHS provide exceptional care to our animals and aiding in our fight to reduce stray litters in the community!

- Age: 21 years or older
- Schedule: Shift based or flexible, depending on position
- Commitment: Varies based on needs
- Skills: General animal handling, valid driver's license and clean driving record.

Bather/Groomer

Give animals a fresh clean start. You will help address the grooming needs of animals that come to RCHS matted, dirty, or just in need of some good cleaning and primping.

- Age: 18 years or older
- Schedule: Flexible
- Commitment: Varies based on needs
- Skills: General animal handling and previous grooming experience.

Canine Companion

Assist with the overall care of RCHS dogs by helping staff provide a clean and enriching environment during their stay. You'll provide the dogs with the exercise and socialization they need, keep their environment clean, and teach them basic manners through positive training and reinforcement.

- Age: 18 years or older to volunteer alone; 16 years or older with a parent
- Schedule: Shift based
 - Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday:
 - 7:30-8:30 am, 8:00-9:00 am, 9:00-10:00 am, 10:00-11:00 am, 11:00 am-12:00 pm, 12:00-1:00 pm, 1:00-2:00 pm, 2:00-3:00 pm, 3:00-4:00 pm, 4:00-5:00 pm, 5:00-6:00 pm, 6:00-7:00 pm.
 - Wednesday, Saturday, and Sunday:
 - 7:30-8:30 am, 8:00-9:00 am, 9:00-10:00 am, 10:00-11:00 am, 11:00 am-12:00 pm, 12:00-1:00 pm, 1:00-2:00 pm, 2:00-3:00 pm, 3:00-4:00 pm, 4:00-5:00 pm
- Commitment: 1 shift per week for 6 months
- Skills: Basic dog handling and understanding of canine behavior; ability to squat, bend, twist, lift, or stand for long periods.

Feline Friend

Assist with the overall care of RCHS cats by helping staff provide a clean and enriching environment during their stay. You'll give the cats love, attention, and the exercise they need, help keep their environment clean, and brush them and keep them tidy if they enjoy being groomed.

- Age: 18 years or older to volunteer alone; 16 years or older with a parent
- Schedule: Shift-based
 - Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday
 - 11:30 am-12:30 pm, 12:30-1:30 pm, 1:30-2:30 pm, 2:30-3:30 pm, 3:30-4:30 pm, 4:30-5:30 pm, 5:30-6:30 pm
 - Wednesday, Saturday, and Sunday
 - 11:30 am-12:30 pm, 12:30-1:30 pm, 1:30-2:30 pm, 2:30-3:30 pm, 3:30-4:30 pm
- Commitment: 1 shift per week for 6 months.
- Skills: Basic cat handling and understanding of feline behavior; ability to squat, bend, twist, lift, or stand for long periods.

Foster Parent

Care for animals that need time in a home setting before becoming available for adoption. Potential foster animals include nursing moms with litters, litters that are too small for adoption and need time to grow (neonates), animals in need of socialization, and animals recovering from illness or injury. RCHS will assist in providing all necessary supplies such as food, litter, bedding, etc to their foster animals if the foster parent is unable to provide these on their own. RCHS provides customary care and needed medications. Required to bring foster animals to mobile adoption events as appropriate.

- Age: 18 years or older
- Commitment: 1 year.
- Skills: Basic animal handling and knowledge of animal behavior, landlord approval if renting, and appropriate time and space to care for foster animal(s).

Photography Assistant

Help us reunite lost pets with their owners and find new homes for the homeless pets in our care by taking photos of the animals. Uploading photos to our data tracking system will automatically post them to our web site and other pet adoption sites to aid people looking for their lost pet or their new best friend. Your own high resolution digital camera is required.

- Age: 18 years or older
- Schedule: 2 hour shifts; specific hours can be flexible
 - Monday, Tuesday, Thursday & Friday 11:00 am - 6:30 pm
 - Wednesday: 11:00 am - 4:30 pm
- Commitment: 1 regularly scheduled shift per week
- Skills: Basic animal handling and behavior knowledge, general computer skills, experience using a digital camera.

Animal Ambassadors:

Animal Resource Specialist

Provide friendly and efficient customer service to RCHS clients while helping to reunite lost pets with their owners and assisting adopters in selecting their new 4-legged family member.

Reception Duties: You will assist staff in directing traffic and answering client questions, complete general office work to keep a clean and organized reception area, and help us reunite lost pets with their owners.

Adoption Duties: Work with adopters to find suitable adoption matches by discussing their pet experience and expectations as well as providing them accurate information about our animals. When a match is made, you will assist them in completing necessary paperwork and help set them up for adoption success!

- Age: 18 years or older
- Schedule: 2-4 hour shifts during the following hours:
 - Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday 12:00pm-6:30pm
 - Saturday and Sunday 12:00pm-4:30pm
- Commitment: 1 regularly scheduled shift per week for 6 months
- Skills: Excellent customer service and communication skills, basic animal handling, knowledge of animal behavior and good pet care, general computer proficiency and data entry experience, ability to multi-task.

Mobile Adoption Animal Handler

Provide care to adoptable animals away from the shelter at mobile adoption events. This position requires expert animal handling skills as well as a desire to promote shelter programs and animals to the public. Animal Handlers can work with either cats or dogs.

- Age: 18 years or older. A limited number of positions are available for children 16 and older to volunteer with a trained parent. Families interested will be considered on a case by case basis.
- Schedule: 4-6 hour events, mostly weekends & weeknights.
- Commitment: 1 event per month for 6 months. Priority is given to handlers who can commit to a regular schedule, but opportunities exist for those who need more flexibility.
- Skills: Excellent customer service and animal handling skills required. Handlers working with animals at events may be required to provide transportation for themselves and their assigned animal to/from the event location.

Mounds Satellite Adoption Center (MSAC) Assistant

Keep our satellite adoption program up and running! This adoption center is located in the Mounds Pet Food Warehouse store in Janesville. MSAC Assistants provide care for the cats waiting for their forever homes, including socialization, cleaning, and helping adopters select the best animal for their household.

- Age requirement: 18 years or older to volunteer alone; children 16 years and older may be accepted with a trained parent.
- Schedule: Shift-based during MSAC open hours
- Commitment: 1 shift per week for 6 months
- Skills: Excellent customer service and communication skills, basic animal handling, knowledge of animal behavior and good pet care.

Behind the Scenes:

Administrative Assistant

Assist with daily administrative activities including data entry, preparation of mailing materials, and miscellaneous projects.

- Age: 18 years or older
- Schedule: Flexible. Some work can be done from home.
- Commitment: Dependent on current projects.
- Skills: Knowledge of Word and Excel, solid written and verbal communication skills, solid interpersonal skills, strong organizational skills and ability to manage and complete a variety of tasks.

Bake for a Cause

Bake homemade goodies throughout the year to support RCHS through bake sales at our annual fundraising events. Volunteers bake treats such as cookies, brownies, bars, muffins, even mini bread loafs, individually wrap them for sale, and drop them off at the shelter prior to an event.

- Age: Any age volunteers may bake with adult supervision.
- Schedule: Flexible
- Commitment: Minimum of two events per year
- Skills: Baking/cooking experience required.

Building Maintenance & Grounds Assistant

Help with upkeep and maintenance of our shelter and its grounds. You will assist with mowing, snow removal, yard work, donation pick-ups, and other projects as needed.

- Age: 18 years or older
- Schedule: Shift-based or flexible
- Commitment: 4 hours per week for 6 months
- Skills: Valid driver's license, ability to routinely (and safely) lift 50+ pounds.

This release does not apply to claims arising from gross negligence or intentional conduct. Should Rock County Humane Society or anyone acting on their behalf, be required to incur attorney's fees and costs to enforce this agreement, I agree to indemnify and hold them harmless for all such fees and costs.

I agree that Rock County Humane Society may photograph my participation in this program, and I hereby release any such photographs to Rock County Humane Society for use in its programs, publications, and purpose.

Further, I understand that it is a violation of privacy and breach of confidentiality to publicly discuss or disclose any information I may learn about an animal's previous owner or situation. I will treat all animals, people, and property I come into contact with at RCHS with the utmost respect and professionalism. I understand that difficult decisions and situations may present themselves routinely at RCHS, and I will conduct myself with courtesy and respect toward staff, volunteers, and the public at all times.
